## Safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children is defined as:

Protecting children from maltreatment; preventing impairment of children's health or development; ensuring that children grow up in circumstances consistent with the provision of safe and effective care; and taking action to enable all children to have the best outcomes.

Safeguarding is not just about protecting children from deliberate harm. It relates to aspects of school life including:

- Pupils' health and safety
- Providing first aid
- Intimate care

- The use of reasonable force
- Educational visits
  - Internet safety
- Making appropriate arrangements to ensure school security
- Meeting the needs of pupils with medical conditions
