

## English

Genres which will be included are

- Narrative: Portal story (based on the model text *The Door and The Dragon*)
- Persuasive writing - Holiday brochure.
- Explanation text - Life cycle of a frog.
- Poetry - kennings.

In addition to this, the children will be developing their knowledge and understanding in spelling, punctuation and grammar.

We will also be undertaking whole class guided reading, using various novels, extracts and songs.

## History: Anglo Saxons and Scots.

Children will learn about Britain's settlement by Anglo-Saxons and Scots. They will explore who the Anglo-Saxons were and why they invaded and settled in Britain as well as what life was really like and what they left behind.

## Geography: Europe and Study of a Country/ Region

(Greece/Athens). Children will explore where Europe is and what its countries are like; tourism in the Mediterranean; factors affecting migration to Greece. They will also investigate the landscape of Greece, what it is used for and why people visit Athens.

## Computing:

We will be revisiting our basic computer skills, such as saving and retrieving work and using Word and Power point etc. We will also be exploring flat file databases. Children will learn how a flat-file database can be used to organise data in records. They will use tools within a database to order and answer questions about data. They will also create graphs and charts from their own data.
