This term we will be learning to spell tricky words and longer words in line with phase 4 of Twinkl phonics – these will be the home learning challenges. <p>Tapestry: Please log into Tapestry regularly. Children are always really excited for us to share what they have been learning in school with you via this platform.</p>
<p>Woodland Wednesday: Will continue to take place on a Wednesday. Appropriate clothing is needed please. Sunglasses aren't really needed in school, sunhats are more appropriate. Please remember the Forest Schools ethos: <i>There is no such weather as bad weather: just bad clothing</i></p>
